

Visa status for King Abdullah Fellows

US Citizens

- Work with admissions directly, not required to go through the International Student and Scholar Services (ISSS) Office

Spouse of U.S. Citizen

- F-1 visa status if they are enrolled in program and are students
- Come initially as a tourist (B-1/B-2) if not enrolled in program officially. But if they are decided to enroll, they can apply that visa and will want to ask if the visa can be annotated to "prospective student". Otherwise, s/he may have to leave and re-enter once the I-20 is issued.

KA Fellows (Saudi Citizens)

- F-1 visa status and dependents on F-2 visa

Parent of KA Fellows

Interested in studying/taking classes (but not enrolled in program)

- Appropriate visa would be J-1. You will need to be admitted as a special standing student first. If you receive an acceptance you will need to submit a J-1 request to the ISSS office. Please visit the links below for additional information.
